 - Class group, team, neighbourhood, family, ...




A healthy community (1/3)

- 80% proactive vs 20% responsive






A healthy community (2/3) – iceberg of McClelland

Free expression of thoughts, emotions, needs, beliefs and deep longings






A healthy community (3/3) – JOHARI WINDOW

- Transparency generates trust
- Trust is a condition for growth
- More voice and choice in exchange for responsibility
